Gather required tools and locate the cable. It will either be on a lazy susan (a) or within a carton (b). Depending on cable size, the carton may contain a reel.
















Cable installation differs slightly for CHD and EHD panels.




Before securing cable to rack or bracket outside of panel, make sure inside length from side plate to connector is 30-33 in. (76.2-83.82 cm) for proper blade movement.




Cables may enter the panel from either sides or from both sides. If from both sides, cable from left rear corner should be routed to right front, and from right rear to left front.

CHD Panels

(a) Unfasten and remove panel rear cover. (b) Slide out side plate. (c) Install cable gland in side plate. Re-install side plate and rear cover.








EHD Panels

(a1) Unfasten and remove panel rear cover. Remove gland adapter from panel side plate in selected cable entry port. (b1) Feed connectors through side plate (may be removed for better access). Remove gland nut from cable gland, install gland adapter onto gland; re-install gland nut. (c1) Snap gland assembly in side

plate (replace side plate if removed).
